First of all; "howdy" to Silver Hair and thanks for reading....

31 shooters made it out for the fun at our March shoot (held Saturday, March 18) of those shooters only two managed to shoot the match clean; congratulations to **Treacherous Jack** (8th overall and 1st in "Traditional") and **Bear Bones Smith** (4th overall and 1st in "Senior") – honorable mention goes out to my pard **Barbarosa Mike**; he managed to hit all the targets just not neces-

sarily in the "correct order".

We shot 5 stages in March, but we had to put 'em in three bays because of the ongoing work on the range. None of the stages this month were of the "stand and deliver" type (all of them had a fair amount of movement).

Stage One; the JSR "Shotgun Stage" was written by JSR's very own Match Director **Col. Cornelius Gilliam**. The shooter had to put 10 shotgun rounds and 10 pistol rounds on the targets. The storyline had us

saving (or, uh, "offering a hand" to) **Sourdough Smitty**. This stage was shot in 30.91 seconds by **Ramblin' Dave**.

Stage Two was written by me – in this story the shooter had to defend his recently acquired "Pot O' Gold" from the Leprechauns; who wanted it back. The stage required 10 rounds from pistols, 10 rounds from the lever gun and a minimum of 4 shotgun rounds. Fastest time on this stage was 31.61 seconds by **Col. Cornelius Gilliam**. Stage Three, another St. Patrick's Day inspired stage, was penned by **Harley Davidson**. This stage required the shooter to retrieve "gold coins" from a Leprechaun's hat (each coin retrieved and remaining on your person at the end

of the stage netted a .25 second bonus! With 40 coins in the hat it was possible for the shooter to gain a 10-second bonus.) Once the Leprechauns discovered you it was necessary to engage in a shootout with them in order to keep your precious

"gold". This shootout required 10 pistol rounds, nine rifle rounds and four shotgun rounds. Fastest time on this stage was by **Ramblin' Dave** who shot it in a blazin' 24.61 seconds.
